





DEEP BLUE DRESS

Size: 14

Level: Challenging

Material:

Circulo Yarns - Anne 4 balls color #2856

2 mm hook or size to obtain gauge

1 navy blue zipper (17.75")

2 transparent buttons (0.5" x 0.5")

Fabric to line dress

Sewing needle and thread

Sewing machine

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st make: mk skip: sk chain: ch slip st: sl st single crochet: sc double crochet: dc treble crochet: tr Increase: inc decrease: dec

round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

2 tr cluster: 2 tr closed tog in the same base st 4 tr cluster: 4 tr closed together in the same

base st

tr4tog: 4 tr closed together in different base

Sts

Pattern A - follow chart 1

Pattern B - follow chart 2

Pattern C - follow chart 3

Pattern D - follow chart 4

Gauge:

 $26 \text{ S} \times 10 \text{ R} = 4^{"}/10 \text{ cm}$ over Pattern A - chart 1 using hook 2 mm.

TIP:

Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide you along. Arrows indicate direction.

Dress - Part 1 - Top:

Start at waistline. Front and back are worked simultaneously. Crochet back and forth.

R1: follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts.

Work tiers as follows: Tier 1 (R2 - 5): 19 motifs Tier 2 (R6 - 9): 20 motifs Tier 3 (R10 - 13): 22 motifs

Flatten piece and divide into front and back.

Work sides separately.

Left back continuation:

Tier 4 (R14 - 17): 5 motifs.

R18 - 20 (3 rows): Follow Pattern B - chart 2

and rep sts = 85 sts.

R21 (chain arches): *1 sc, ch 5* rep from * to *

13 more times, 1 sc.

Tier 5 (R22 - 25): 4 motifs, end left side with 1

half motif.

R26 - 28 (3 rows): Follow Pattern B - chart 2

and rep sts = 85 sts. Follow Pattern A again.

R29 (chain arches): *1 sc, ch 5* rep from * to *

13 more times, 1 sc.

Tier 6 (R30 - 33): 4 motifs, end left side with 1

half motif.

Tier 7 (R34 - 37): 4 motifs, end left side with 1

half motif.

Right back continuation:

Tier 4 (R14 - 17): 5 motifs.

R18 - 20 (3 rows): Follow Pattern B - chart 2

and rep sts = 85 sts.

R21 (chain arches): *1 sc, ch 5* rep from * to *

13 more times, 1 sc.

Tier 5 (R22 - 25): 4 motifs, end left side with 1 half motif.

R26 - 28 (3 rows): Follow Pattern B - chart 2 and rep sts = 85 sts.

Follow Pattern A again.

R29 (chain arches): *1 sc, ch 5* rep from * to * 13 more times, 1 sc.

Tier 6 (R30 - 33): end right side with 1 half motif, 4 motifs.

Tier 7 (R34 - 37): end right side with 1 half motif, 4 motifs.

Front continuation:

Tier 4 (R14 - 17): 10 motifs.

R18 - 20 (3 rows): Follow Pattern B - chart 2 and rep sts = 171 sts.

R21 (chain arches): *1 sc, ch 5* rep from * to * 28 more times, 1 sc.

Tier 5 (R22 - 25): start right side with 1 half motif, 8 motifs, end right side with 1 half motif.

R26 - 28 (3 rows): Follow Pattern B - chart 2 and rep sts = 155 sts.

Follow Pattern A again.

R29 (chain arches): *1 sc, ch 5* rep from * to * 25x, 1 sc.

Tier 6 (R30 - 33): start right side with 1 half motif, 8 motifs, end right side with 1 half motif.

Neckline shaping: do not work on the 4 central motifs in the next tier. Work sides separately. Left side

Tier 7 (R34 - 37): start right side with 1 half motif, 2 motifs. Fasten off.

Right side

Tier 7 (R34 - 37): start with 2 motifs, end left size with 1 half motif. Fasten off.

Join shoulders:

Use tapestry needle and Anne to sew shoulders together (4.75"), leave 8" for arms.

Dress - Part 2 - Skirt:

Crochet back and front simultaneously. Crochet back and forth.

Join yarn at foundation chain of Part 1. Start at right back, front and left back.

R38 - 40 (3 rows): Follow Pattern B - chart 2 and rep sts = 251 sts.

R41 (chain arches): *1 sc, ch 5* rep from * to * 59x, 1 sc.

Tier 8 (R42 - 45): 20 motifs.

Crochet in the round.

Follow Pattern C - chart 3 and rep sts.

Tier 9 (R46 - 49): 23 motifs.

Tier 10 (R50 - 53) 23 motifs

Tier 11 (R54 - 57): 23 motifs

Tier 12 (R58 - 61): 23 motifs

Tier 13 (R62 - 65): 25 motifs.

R66 - 68 (3 rows): Follow Pattern D - chart 4 and rep sts = 452 sts.

R69 (chain arches): *1 sc, ch 5* rep from * to *

114 more times, 1 sl st to close rnd.

Tier 14 (R70 - 73): 38 motifs

Tier 15 (R74 - 77): 30 motifs

Tier 16 (R78 - 81): 38 motifs

R82 - 84 (3 rows): Follow Pattern D - chart 4 and rep sts = 684 sts.

Follow Pattern C again.

R85 (chain arches): *1 sc, ch 5* rep from * to *

114 more times, 1 sl st to close rnd.

Tier 17 (R86 - 89): 38 motifs

Tier 18 (R90 - 93): 38 motifs

Tier 19 (R94 - 97): 30 motifs.

Collar:

Join Anne at neckline. Start at left back, front and right back. Crochet back and forth.

R1 - 5: Follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts -10 motifs


Switch to sewing needles and thread. Sew 2 buttons on the right back onto collar.

Finishing:

Use tapestry needle to sew sleeve onto body, aligning tiers. Make a little pleat on top of sleeve.

Lining:

Use crochet dress as a template to make slip.





BORDEAUX DRESS

Created by: Angélica Schmitt

Size: 4

Level: Challenging

Material

Circulo Yarns - Clea

3 balls color #3794 bordeaux

1.25 mm hook or size to obtain gauge

Tapestry needle

10 yds of bordeaux round elastic

2 transparent buttons (0.5" x 0.5")

Fabric to line dress

Sewing needle and thread

Sewing machine

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st make: mk skip: sk chain: ch slip st: sl st

single crochet: sc

Half double crochet: hdc

double crochet: dc treble crochet: tr Increase: inc decrease: dec round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor.

3 tr cluster: 3 tr closed tog in the same base st

Pattern A - top - follow chart 1

Pattern B - top back - follow chart 2

Pattern C - skirt - follow chart 3

Pattern D - hemline - follow chart 4

Gauge: $38 \text{ S x } 9 \text{ R} = 4^{"}/10 \text{ cm over Pattern A} - 4^{"}$

chart 1 using hook 1.25 mm.

TIP: Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide you along. Arrows indicate direction.

Dress - top front

Use hook 1.25 mm. Crochet back and forth. Start at shoulders.

z c l l l l

Left shoulder

Ch 49.

R1 - 8: follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts.

Fasten off.

Right shoulder

Ch 49.

R1 - 8: follow Pattern A - chart 1 and rep sts. At the end of R8, ch 39 (neckline) and join left

shoulder panel with 1 sl st.

R9 - 18: continue following Pattern A - chart 1.

Fasten off and set piece aside.

Dress - Back

Use hook 1.25 mm. Crochet back and forth.

Start at shoulders.

Left shoulder

Ch 161.

R1 - 18: follow Pattern B - chart 2 and rep sts.

Fasten off.

Join panels: Use tapestry needle to join shoulders (6.25") and sides (0.5"), leave 7.5" open

for arms.

Skirt

Front and back are worked simultaneously.

Crochet in the round.

Use crochet hook 1.25 mm.

R1 - 62: follow Pattern C - chart 3 and rep sts.

Hemline

R1 - 14: follow Pattern D - chart 4 and rep sts.

Fasten off.

Slevees (make 2)

Join yarn at armhole. Crochet in the round.

R1 - 15: follow Pattern E - chart 5. Fasten off.

Finishina

Use crochet hook 1.25 mm to work around neckline.

R1 & 2: sc


R3: sl sts.


At 4.75" from the beginning of skirt, insert 4


















ANTIQUE PINK DRESS

Size: 18

Level: Advanced

Material:

Circulo Yarns - Anne

5 balls color #3227 antique pink

 $1.76 \ \text{mm}$ and $2 \ \text{mm}$ hooks or size to obtain

gauge

Tapestry needle

1 zipper (12")

Fabric to line dress

Sewing needle and thread

Sewing machine

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

stitch: st
make: mk
skip: sk
chain: ch
slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
Crab st: left to right sc
half double crochet: hdc
double crochet: dc

picot: ch 3, 1 sl st Increase: inc decrease: dec

round: rnd

end of row/rnd: eor. 2 dc cluster: 2 dc closed tog in the same base st 3 dc cluster: 3 dc closed tog in the same base st Pattern A - follow chart 1 Pattern B - follow chart 2

Pattern C - follow chart 3

Pattern D - follow chart 4

Pattern E - follow chart 5

Pattern F - follow chart 6

TIP: Transfer measurement chart to paper to guide you along. Arrows indicate direction.

Dress - Part 1 - skirt

Front and back are worked simultaneously. Start at waistline. Crochet in the round. Use crochet kook 2 mm.

Foundation cord (see glossary): make 90 loops, close with 1 sl st.

R1 - 49: follow Pattern A- chart 1 and rep sts = 15 motifs in each rnd.

Part 2 - Top

Front and back are worked simultaneously. Start at center of back. Crochet in the round. Use crochet kook 1.75 mm. Join yarn at the other side of the skirt foundation cord. R50 - 65: follow Pattern B - chart 2 and rep sts = 15 motifs in each.

Part 3 - Crochet back and forth.

Start at left back, front and right back.
R66 - 72: follow Pattern C - chart 3 and rep sts
= 15 motifs each.
Work sides separately.

Part 4 - left and righ back continuation.

Work sides separately.

R73 - 95: follow Pattern D - chart 4 and rep sts. Fasten off.

Part 5 - front continuation

R73 - 95: follow Pattern E - chart 5 and rep sts. Fasten off.

Join shoulders

Use tapestry needle and Anne to sew shoulders (5.5")

Part 6 - Sleeves (make 2)

Use hook 1.75 mm. Crochet in the round. Join yarn at armhole.

R96 - 116: follow Pattern F - chart 6 and rep sts

Finishing

Use crochet hook 1.75 mm. Work around neckline and back opening. Crochet back and forth.


