## MATERIALS

WOOL - GREEN 400-500g

(I USE HIMALAYA DOLPHIN WOOL FROM AMAZON)

COTTON YARN

4,5MM AND 5,0MM HOOK

STUFFING

STITCH MARKER

TAPESTRY NEEDLE

SCISSORS

LIGHTER IF NECESSARY

(I USE IT FOR WOOL ENDS)

- SEWING TOGETHER IS A BIT DIFFICULT, SO THIS IS NOT A PATTERN FOR BEGINNERS
- WHEN SEWING THE INDIVIDUAL LEAF RINGS TOGETHER, YOU HAVE TO IMPROVISE A LITTLE BIT
- AFTER EACH ROW YOU MUST DO CH3, THESE COUNT AS THE FIRST DC OF THE FOLLOWING ROW\*
- AFTER THE LAST ROW CHAIN ONLY 1 AND THEN DO THE BOTTOM LINE
- DO ALL LEAFS WITH 4,5MM HOOK AND THE CIRCLE WITH 5,0MM HOOK

## FIRST LEAF ROW - TINY LEAFS 3x

DO A RING WITH CH4 AND SLST INTO THE FIRST CH, CH 3 (YOU CAN ALSO DO A MR)


**R1** 9DC IN RING (NOW TIGHTEN THE RING, BUT DON'T MAKE A SLST OR SOMETHING), \*CH3 AND  
TURN YOUR WORK (YOU WORK BACK ON YOUR STITCHES)

**R2** 4DC, (6DC IN NEXT STITCH), 5DC (LAST DC IN THIRD CH FROM THE STARTING ROW), (CH1)  
10 SC ALONG THE BOTTOM

CUT THE YARN -> MAKE 3 AND SEW THE ENDS IN WHEN YOU WANT TO  
(YOU CAN ALSO HIDE THEM LATER)




NOW MAKE ANOTHER 3 AND DO NOT CUT THE YARN AFTER ONE  
DO THE NEXT STEP:

CH1, PUT TWO LEAFS TOGETHER (WS FACING) AND MAKE SC ALONG THE SIDES, SLST  
IN THE MEANTIME STUFF A LITTLE BIT (NOT TO MUCH), THEN CUT THE YARN AND SEW END IN  
-> MAKE THIS 3x



## CROCHET THE LEAFS TOGETHER LIKE THIS:

DO 5SC ON THE BOTTOM THAT YOU SEE THE WRONG  
SIDE AND THE RIGHT SIDES FACING EACH OTHER



## SECOND LEAF ROW - SMALL LEAF 3x

REPEAT R1-2\*

R3 7DC, (6DC IN NEXT STITCH), 8DC\*

R4 10DC, (6DC IN NEXT STITCH), 11DC, (CH1)

16SC ALONG THE BOTTOM

CUT THE YARN -> MAKE 3 AND SEW THE ENDS IN

NOW MAKE ANOTHER 3 AND DO NOT CUT THE YARN AFTER ONE

DO THE NEXT STEP:


CH1, PUT TWO LEAFS TOGETHER (**WS FACING**) AND MAKE SC ALONG THE SIDES, SLST

IN THE MEANTIME STUFF A LITTLE BIT (**NOT TO MUCH**), THEN CUT THE YARN AN SEW END IN

-> MAKE THIS 3x

## SEW THE LEAFS TOGETHER LIKE THIS:

SEW 5SC TOGETHER ON THE BOTTOM THAT YOU SEE THE  
WRONG SIDE AND THE RIGHT SIDES FACING EACH OTHER



DO IT ON EVERY SIDE



THE COLOR OF THE COTTON  
YARN DOESN'T MATTER, YOU  
DON'T SEE IT LATER WHEN YOU  
PULL IT TIGHTLY TOGETHER

### THIRD LEAF ROW - MIDDLE LEAFS 5x

REPEAT R1-R4\*

R5 13DC, (6DC IN NEXT STITCH), 14DC, (CH1)

20SC ALONG THE BOTTOM

CUT THE YARN -> MAKE 5 AND SEW THE ENDS IN

NOW MAKE ANOTHER 5 AND DO NOT CUT THE YARN AFTER ONE

DO THE NEXT STEP:

CH1, PUT TWO LEAFS TOGETHER (**WS FACING**) AND MAKE SC ALONG THE SIDES, SLST


IN THE MEANTIME STUFF A LITTLE BIT (**NOT TO MUCH**), THEN CUT THE YARN AN SEW END IN

-> MAKE THIS 5x

### SEW THE LEAFS TOGETHER LIKE THIS:

SEW 6SC TOGETHER ON THE BOTTOM THAT YOU SEE THE  
WRONG SIDE AND THE RIGHT SIDES FACING EACH OTHER

SEW IT LIKE THE SMALL ONES



## LAST LEAF ROW – BIG LEAFS 5x

REPEAT R1-R5\*

R6 16DC, (6DC IN NEXT STITCH), 17DC, (CH1)

24SC ALONG THE BOTTOM

CUT THE YARN -> MAKE 5 AND SEW THE ENDS IN


NOW MAKE ANOTHER 5 AND DO NOT CUT THE YARN AFTER ONE

DO THE NEXT STEP:

CH1, PUT TWO LEAFS TOGETHER (**WS FACING**) AND MAKE SC ALONG THE SIDES, SLST  
IN THE MEANTIME STUFF A LITTLE BIT (**NOT TO MUCH**), THEN CUT THE YARN AN SEW END IN  
-> MAKE THIS 5x

### SEW THE LEAFS TOGETHER LIKE THIS:

SEW 3SC TOGETHER ON THE BOTTOM THAT YOU SEE THE  
WRONG SIDE AND THE RIGHT SIDES FACING EACH OTHER




## BACK CIRCLE WITH 5MM HOOK

R1	11DC IN MR	(11)
R2	11INC	(22)
R3	(DC, INC) 11x	(33)
R4	(2DC, INC) 11x	(44)
R5	(3DC, INC) 11x	(55)
R6	(4DC, INC) 11x	(66)
R7	(5DC, INC) 11x	(77)



## SEWING

- WHEN SEWING TOGETHER, YOU NOW HAVE TO IMPROVISE A LITTLE
- FOR SEWING I USE A THICK COTTON YARN BECAUSE IT'S MORE STABLE
- TRY TO ARRANGE THE INDIVIDUAL ROWS AS IN THE PICTURE 
- SEW THE FIRST ROW TOGETHER WITH THE SECOND BY SEWING THE OPEN MIDDLE TO THE MIDDLE OF THE FIRST ROW
- NOW YOU SEW THE THIRD ROW WITH THE OPEN SIDES TO THE LEAFS OF THE SECOND ROW
- THE FOURTH ROW IS FASTENED WITH THE OPEN SIDES JUST LIKE THE THIRD
- IF THERE ARE STILL A FEW GAPS OR YOU DON'T LIKE IT, TRY SEWING THEM SO THAT IT LOOKS GOOD FOR YOU
- FINALLY, SEW THE CIRCLE TO THE BOTTOM – THIS MAKES THE UNDERSIDE MORE BEAUTIFUL (I ALSO PULL ANOTHER THREAD THROUGH THE MIDDLE OF THE CIRCLE AND THE MIDDLE OF THE TINY LEAFS FOR THE SHAPE)



I PIN THE INDIVIDUAL ROWS TOGETHER SO  
THAT I CAN SEW THEM TOGETHER BETTER
