

# Cat Paw Half-Finger Gloves – Complete Crochet Pattern

These adorable cat paw half-finger gloves are reversible, playful, and perfect for adding a cute touch to your cold-weather accessories. Designed to be worn on both sides, this pattern combines simple stitches with clever shaping to create a unique and functional piece.

The pattern was carefully adapted from a video tutorial and rewritten into a clear, structured, step-by-step crochet pattern using standard US terms. The gloves are worked flat in panels and then joined, making the construction easy to understand while still offering beautiful texture and detail.

Decorative paw pads and a heart appliqué complete the design, giving the gloves their signature kawaii look. This pattern is suitable for confident beginners and intermediate crocheters.

## Materials

- Medium weight yarn (main color + contrast colors)
- Crochet hook suitable for yarn used
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Hot glue or needle and thread for appliqués
- Stitch markers (optional)

## Abbreviations (US Terms)

ch – chain  
sl st – slip stitch  
sc – single crochet  
hdc – half double crochet  
dc – double crochet  
inc – increase (2 stitches in same stitch)  
sk – skip

## Pattern Notes

- Gloves are worked flat and then joined
- Design is reversible
- Stitch counts at corners are essential for shaping
- Read entire pattern before starting

## Front Panel

Foundation:

Ch 15.

Starting from the second-to-last chain, sc 13.

In the first chain, work 3 sc.

Turn.

Row 1: Sc 13. Sl st. Turn.

Row 2: Sc 13, inc in each of the 3 corner stitches (6 sts), sc 13. Sl st. Turn.

Row 3: Sc 1, inc in next stitch, continue increasing every other stitch in corner until 9 sc are formed, sc 13. Turn.

Rows 4–6: Continue sc across, adding 3 stitches at each corner per row.

Row 7: Sc 10, hdc 2, dc 3. In corner section: dc 3, inc every 3 stitches until 20 dc. Dc 3, hdc 2, sc 11. Sl st. Turn.

Row 8: Sc 11, hdc 1, \*sk 1, 5 dc in next stitch\* repeat across decorative section. Continue following stitch placement. Sl st. Turn.

Row 9: Sc 17, inc (2 dc) in each of the 3 center dc stitches, sc 3, repeat dc increases, finish with sc 13. Fasten off.

## Back Panel

Work Rows 1–7 the same as the Front Panel.

Rows 8–9 are worked in the opposite direction to mirror the front.

Fasten off after Row 9.

## Joining the Panels

Place front and back panels together.

Join yarn and sc through both layers along the side.

Work 12 sc, leaving openings for fingers and thumb.

Continue joining between fingers using sc until panels are fully joined.

## Bottom Edge

Attach yarn at side.

Work 36 sc evenly around the bottom edge.

Sl st to join.

## Finger Ribbing

Ch 7.

Starting in second chain, work 6 hdc.

Attach to glove with sl st.

Turn and work in back loops only.

Repeat around, skipping 12 sc total.

Sew side seam to secure.

## Wrist Rounds

Work 2 rounds of hdc evenly around the wrist (36 sts per round).

## Paw Pad Appliqué

Magic ring.

Work 10 sc into ring.

Pull tight.

Sl st and fasten off.

## Heart Appliqué

Magic ring.

Ch 3, work 3 dc, ch 1.

Work 3 dc, ch 3, sl st.

Tighten ring.

Work sc evenly around heart.

Fasten off.

## Finishing

Weave in all ends securely.

Attach paw pad and heart appliqués using hot glue or sewing.

Block lightly if needed.

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
