

Granny Hexagon Doll Crochet Pattern



Abbreviations (US Terms)

- ch = chain
- ch-sp = chain space
- sl st = slip stitch
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- MR = magic ring
- BLO = back loop only
- sc2tog = single crochet 2 together (decrease)
- hdc2tog = half double crochet 2 together (decrease)
- 2sc in 1 = increase

- granny cluster = 3 dc
- (16) = stitch count at end of round

Body and Arms (Make 2 Granny Hexagons)

You will crochet **8 rounds total**:

- Round 1 = starting chain ring
- Rounds 2–8 = granny stitch

Round 1

Ch 5, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Round 2

Ch 3 (counts as first dc).

Work **around the chain ring**:

2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3 ×5.

Join with sl st in 3rd starting chain.

(6 granny clusters)

Round 3

Sl st 3 times to first ch-3 space.

(3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1) in same space, skip next cluster.

Repeat around.

(12 granny clusters)

Round 4

Corners: (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1)

Sides: (3 dc, ch 1)

(18 granny clusters)

Rounds 5–8

- Round 5: 24 clusters
- Round 6: 30 clusters
- Round 7: 36 clusters
- Round 8: 42 clusters

Corners always: **3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 1**

Sides always: **3 dc, ch 1**

Make 2 hexagons (they may slightly ripple).

Fold each hexagon in half and seam along the indicated line using **BLO only** for a flat seam.

Joining the Body

Join shoulder seams, leaving **2 stitches open at each corner** in the neckline for attaching the head later.

Bottom of body and armholes remain open.

Legs (Make 2)

Attach yarn at the bottom of the body.

Round 1

(3 dc, ch 1), skip 1 cluster — repeat around.
(8 granny clusters)

Rounds 2–7

Repeat Round 1.

Round 8

sc2tog around (16)

Round 9

sc around (16)

Round 10

sc2tog around (8)

Fasten off, leave yarn for sewing foot.

Feet / Shoes (Make 2)

Worked in the round starting from a chain.

Rounds 1–14 shape the foot with increases, BLO round, then decreases.

Stuff during Round 9–10.

Close and sew foot to leg.

Arms (Make 2)

Attach yarn in corner ch-3 space.

- Round 1: sc2tog around (15)
- Round 2: sc around (15)
- Round 3: (sc, sc2tog) ×5 = 10

Fasten off, leave yarn for hands.

Hands (Make 2)

Worked like small ovals from a chain.

Stuff during Round 9.

Close and sew to arms.

Head

Worked in continuous rounds.

- Round 1: 6 sc in MR
- Round 2: inc around (12)
- Continue increasing to **48 sts**
- Rounds 9–14: sc around
- Begin decreasing
- Stuff during Round 18
- Close at Round 21

Attach head to neckline (it should hang slightly).

Embroidered Face

Count rounds from bottom of head:

- **Mouth:** Round 8, over 5 sts
- **Nose:** Rounds 10–11, over 2 sts
- **Eyes:** Round 12, over 3 sts, with 4 sts between

Hat

Worked in joined rounds, then spirals.

Start with **52 chains**, join to form a ring.

Decrease gradually until 6 sts remain.

Continue straight to form tip.

Sew closed.

Pom-Pom for Hat

Small ball worked in sc, stuffed and sewn to hat tip.

Bow

Worked in MR with dc clusters, cinched in the middle and sewn to hat.

Collar

Ch 12.

Work dc and chain spaces to create a ruffled collar.

Sew around neckline.
